### **Purpose**

#### **Background**

The Green Economy programme, being delivered on behalf of West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA) by the Green Economy team within the Growth Company, aims to support the growth of the green technologies and services sector in West Yorkshire. The programme aims to support innovation through:

- encouragement of adoption of new products and processes to drive business growth;
- boost productivity by supporting organisations to streamline operations, increasing competitiveness;
- win more work for green technology organisations in the area by supporting them to enter new markets and access new sales opportunities,
- and tackle climate change in the area by accelerating the transition to net zero with enhanced green products and services available.

As part of the programme delivery, Winning Moves (an independent subsidiary of Growth Company) is acting as 'critical friend' and evaluating the success of the Green Economy programme and identifying learnings for WYCA to take forward to possible related activities.

In order to evaluate the programme, we (Winning Moves) will need to process personal data of the supported businesses.

#### Data controller and data processors

For the purposes of this project:

- WYCA / Green Economy are the data controller.
- Winning Moves is the data processor.

#### Type of data that will be processed

For this project, we will process the following types of personal data:

- Simple data including your name, your organisation name, organisation email address, and organisation telephone number.
- Behavioural data including your experience with / thoughts / opinions / feedback on the programme.

#### How we get the personal data we process

Simple data will be securely shared with us by Green Economy team for the purpose of delivering the survey.



Behavioural data will be collected from you when you participate in the online survey.

#### The legal bases for processing your personal data

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- **Legitimate Interest:** The secure sharing of your contact details with us for the purposes of getting in touch with you as a supported business is being done so under the lawful basis of 'legitimate interest'. This is because Green Economy have a legitimate business interest to understand the success of the programme and draw together learnings for future, similar activities.
- **Consent**: Obtaining additional personal data, including your opinions about, and changes in behaviour because of, the programme, is being done so under the lawful basis of 'consent'. Prior to commencing the interview with you, we will explicitly seek your consent to collect and process your personal data. Informed consent is always collected by way of an affirmative action (such as selecting 'next' to continue with an online survey). You can withdraw your consent at any time by emailing dataprotection@winningmoves.com

#### How we will use your personal data

Your personal data will be used in the following ways:

- Behavioural data you provide will be aggregated and reported anonymously to the green Economy / WYCA as our client. It should be noted that we will endeavour to make sure that you cannot be identified by any quotes or other responses, however, as the sample pool is small, this may not always be entirely possible.
- No automated profiling will take place.
- Data may be linked to outcome data provided by WYCA for the purpose of understanding what types of businesses have had what outcomes.

#### Will we share your personal data?

Your personal data will be shared with the following third parties:

- Green Economy will receive a copy of anonymised responses. However, as above, it may not be entirely possible to ensure that businesses will not be identifiable from their responses.
- Our sub-processors who may carry out some of the processing on Winning Moves' behalf, and under Winning Moves control. An example of this might include the service provider who hosts our survey platform, IdSurvey.
- We may share your data with a third party purely for the purpose of delivering a function on our behalf. They will have access to personal information to perform the function but will not use it for any other purpose.

Any third party must process the personal information as set out in this Privacy Policy and as permitted by the UK's Data Protection Act/laws.

How we will keep your personal data



Your information will be securely stored. We will protect the confidentiality of your information in accordance with our normal data handling procedures and all legal requirements. We will not use it for any purposes other than those which are set out in this Notice. We are committed to keeping personal data secure and take all reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal data from loss, misuse or alteration.

The length of time we hold your personal information varies depending upon the type of information and its use. We will hold your personal information on our systems only for as long as necessary to provide research services to our clients, and will anonymise data where possible, securely deleting personal data associated with it at the earliest possible point. For this project, we intend to keep raw survey data for six months following completion of the project – we expect this to be September 2025. We will then dispose your information by secure digital deletion.

#### Where your personal data will be processed

Your data will not be transferred or stored outside the UK or European Economic Area.

## **Your Rights**

Co-operation in research is voluntary at all times regardless of what the research is about or who our client is. You are entitled at any stage to ask that your personal data, or part or all of the record of your survey responses, be destroyed or deleted and we will carry out such a request. This can be requested during the interview itself or afterwards. You have the right to access any personal data that we process relating to you. We may ask for verification of your identity before releasing any information to you.
